

# Community Speed Watch Sussex Monthly Update – Force Overview September 2021



**285**

**Registered CSW groups.**

There are currently 285 registered CSW groups in Sussex, 182 of these are Parish Council Run Groups.

**72**

**CSW groups active this month.**

During this month 72 groups have completed sessions on the roads of Sussex.

**23**

**Police SpeedWatch sessions.**

This month Sussex Police have completed 23 Speedwatch sessions / visits to support Community Groups.

**7,041**

**Reports generated over last month.**

Last month CSW group's generated 7,041 reports through Op Crackdown 40 of those reports are reports of abuse to groups from drivers.

**66,374**

**Reports over twelve months.**

In the last 12 months 66,374 reports were generated, compared to 47,702 for the same period last year.

**160**

**Vehicles observed with no MOT.**

Last month CSW volunteers recorded 107 vehicles passing with no MOT and 17 SORN.

**513**

**CSW Sessions this Month.**

This month CSW volunteers have completed 513 roadside sessions in Sussex.

**1,267**

**Force Volunteer Hours.**

This month the number of Force volunteer hours given by groups was 1,267.

Project Edward (Every Day Without A Road Death) took place in September, this with support from Sussex Police Officers and Staff across the County achieved some outstanding work, Groups recorded between the 13<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> September 2,421 records, although outstanding work from the Groups demonstrates the importance of getting this message across that speed is unacceptable and is rightly considered anti-social driving. Thank you again to all the Groups that took part.

Sussex Police Neighbourhood Policing Teams have carried out this month 23 SpeedWatch sessions and visits to Groups across the Force in support of Community Speedwatch Groups and #Operation Downsway (the Force response to anti-social driving), as well as visits to Groups at the roadside by Casualty Reduction Officers, Special Constables and Roads Policing Officers, this does not include separate Operations run by SSRP Casualty Reduction RPU and local NPT.

The Sussex Police repeat offenders compliance rate currently stands at 93.31%, this ratio is based on drivers who have received the first letter from us not going back through the CSW system within a 12 month period, (this data is based on group record input).
