Other items to take note of;

Number Plate thefts; You will notice in the above there have been a few thefts of number plates from vehicle, with the high cost of petrol they are often used in "Drive Off" thefts at petrol stations. If your plates get stolen make sure you report it to the Police because they are likely going to be used in some sort of criminal activity, if they get used on a vehicle that is the same make and model it will help avoid problems if Police come knocking on your door later.

Breaks to vehicles and outbuildings; As always vehicles, sheds and out buildings are prone to break ins, make sure your vehicles and buildings are secure, and do not leave valuable items in vehicles overnight.

Garden tools and machinery; At this time of year many of us will be busy in the garden with lots of tools and machinery, make sure it is all locked away securely when you have finished using it.
