REPORTS	339	Total number of reports sent to Operation Crackdown with video evidence and processed by Casualty Reduction Officers (CRO's).
FATAL FIVE	260	Number of reports sent to Operation Crackdown this month with viewable video footage of FATAL FIVE offences as well as CLOSE PASS, WHITE LINE offences.
OTHER OFFENCES		Video reports made that do not fall under the FATAL FIVE but are looked at by the CRO's. These include CLOSE PASS offences, RED LIG offences.
NIP	59	The number of video reports that have been suitable to serve a NOTICE OF INTENDED PROSECUTION (NIP) to the registered owner of tl
TRAINING	44	The number of NIP's that have been served with a recommendation that the driver completes a driver retraining course in lieu of penalty poin
PROSECUTIONS	5	The number offences where either a conditional offer (points & fine) is made or the matter deemed so serious that it is heard in court.
LETTERS	138	Number of educational letters that have been sent to drivers as a result of video reports sent to Operation Crackdown. Designed to be an educ safer driving and point out poor driving.
OUTCOME		The percentage of video reports that are sent in to Operation Crackdown which have resulted in positive action being taken using some of the above.

Operation Crackdown is an initiative run by Sussex Safer Roads Partnership, which gives the communities of Sussex an opportunity to report specific instances of anti-social driving, as well as abandoned vehicles

The Sussex Police repeat offenders' compliance rate currently stands at 93.61%, this ratio is based on drivers who have received the first letter from us not going back through the CSW system within a 12-month period, (this data is based on group record input).

Monthly CSW virtual Coordinator's meetings are now held to enable groups and Parish Councils to establish a collaborative working network, this also enables SSRP to give any updates and feedback constructively to the groups.
