Catalytic converters;

Thefts of catalytic converters in Kent and Sussex continues to be a problem, there are five listed above and I have been informed of several recent thefts in the Hawkhurst and Cranbrook and Wadhurst areas.

Garden machinery:

It is the time of the year when a lot of work with machinery is in use in our gardens, at the end of the days work make sure your machines are securely locked away, and during the day if you stop for a meal break make sure you have not left expensive machines where they are out of your sight and easily stolen.

Make sure and report all incidents and break in attempts as soon as possible, even if nothing is stolen, report to **101**, **BUT** if you are sure a criminal act is in progress **999**.
