There are currently 329 registered CSW groups in Sussex, 196 of these are Parish Council Run Groups.

During this month 74 groups have completed sessions on the roads of Sussex.

This month Sussex Police have recorded 14 reports on Speedwatch sessions / 14 visits to support Community Groups.

Last month CSW Group's reported 110 instances of abuse to Sussex Police.

**BODY WORN VIDEO IS NOW USED** 

In the last 12 months 60,292 reports were generated.

This month's vehicle records submitted are 5,421, the compliance ratio is 93.49% for non repeat offenders.

This month CSW volunteers have completed 340 roadside sessions in Sussex.

This month the number of Force volunteer hours given by groups was 865.5.

## **April 2023 Highlights**

REPORTS	339	Total number of reports sent to Operation Crackdown with video evidence and processed by Casualty Reduction Officers (CRO's).
FATAL FIVE	260	Number of reports sent to Operation Crackdown this month with viewable video footage of FATAL FIVE offences as well as CLOSE PASS, WHITE LINE offences.
OTHER OFFENCES	79	Video reports made that do not fall under the FATAL FIVE but are looked at by the CRO's. These include CLOSE PASS offences, RED LIG offences.
NIP	59	The number of video reports that have been suitable to serve a NOTICE OF INTENDED PROSECUTION (NIP) to the registered owner of tl
TRAINING	44	The number of NIP's that have been served with a recommendation that the driver completes a driver retraining course in lieu of penalty poin
PROSECUTIONS	5	The number offences where either a conditional offer (points & fine) is made or the matter deemed so serious that it is heard in court.
LETTERS	138	Number of educational letters that have been sent to drivers as a result of video reports sent to Operation Crackdown. Designed to be an educ safer driving and point out poor driving.
OUTCOME		The percentage of video reports that are sent in to Operation Crackdown which have resulted in positive action being taken using some of the above.

Operation Crackdown is an initiative run by Sussex Safer Roads Partnership, this gives the communities of Sussex an opportunity to report specific instances of anti-social driving, as well as abandoned vehicles.

## Any additional message or info.

The Sussex Police repeat offenders' compliance rate currently stands at 93.49%, this ratio is based on drivers who have received the first letter from us not going back through the CSW system within a 12-month period, (this data is based on group record input).

Monthly CSW virtual Coordinator's meetings are now held to enable groups and Parish Councils to establish a collaborative working network, this also enables SSRP to give any updates and feedback constructively to the groups. **Next meeting 13.00hrs -15.00hrs on Friday 21st July 2023**, to get the link send your name, group, and email address to csw@sussex.police.uk
