3 Cloned Vehicles detected by CSW from reports uploaded in October.

2 reports of abuse to operators caught on Body Worn Video resulted in penalties to the driver.

During this month 69 groups have completed sessions on the roads of Sussex.

This month Sussex Police have recorded 13 reports on Speedwatch sessions / 8 visits to support Community Groups.

Last month CSW Group's reported 101 instances of abuse to Sussex Police.

In the last 12 months 53,841 reports were generated.

This month's vehicle records submitted are 3,962, the compliance ratio is 94.50% for non repeat offenders.

This month CSW volunteers have completed 332 roadside sessions in Sussex.

This month the number of Force volunteer hours given by groups was 770.

Monday 30th October saw the first National Community SpeedWatch Police Coffee Morning hosted by Kent Police and Sussex Chief Constable Jo Shiner National Police Chiefs Council lead for Roads Policing. I was able to showcase our work in Sussex to 31 other Forces. I have also been asked to relay on behalf on the NPCC a big thank you to you all on the work that you put into helping to keep the roads in Sussex a safer place to be. Its fair to say we have a gold standard scheme in Sussex compared to some other Forces, future collaboration was discussed as was technology moving forward, and uniformity of best practice. The Sussex Police repeat offenders' compliance rate currently stands at 94.50%, this ratio is based on drivers who have received the first letter from us not going back through the CSW system within a 12-month period, (this data is based on group record input).
