## **Speedwatch Report**

## Parish Council 16th November 2023

During October we ran 115 sessions, totalling 7.5 hours, those sessions recorded 23 speeding vehicles from 1472 passing vehicles, the fastest speed recorded was 55mph.

Three of the sessions did not record any speeding vehicles, but one recorded over 10% of passing vehicles speeding.

A total of seven sessions were cancelled, two because operators were unavailable, two because of road works restricting the vision, the last three sessions in the month were cancelled due to a failure of the IT system that processes the session results data, we were instructed to cancel sessions to avoid adding to the backlog of data waiting to be processed.

We have two new volunteers who have completed training and commenced sessions from the beginning of November.

We have 32 sessions planned for November, assuming that we do not have to cancel any, currently there are 25 sessions planned for December and there may be some more added.
