Dark evenings;

The dark evenings and long winter nights are with us again, while you are nice and cosy in your home those people who want to relieve you of your property are still very much active outside. You can see from the list above that there have been a number of thefts and attempted thefts from sheds, outbuildings and farms. Make sure that all your garages, outbuildings and vehicles are secure, if possible fit motion activated lights where you can, burglars do not like being illuminated. If you see anything suspicious at a neighbours property report it straight away, do not wait till the next day.

Make sure and report all incidents and break in attempts as soon as possible, even if nothing is stolen, report to **101**, **BUT** if you are sure a criminal act is in progress **999**.
